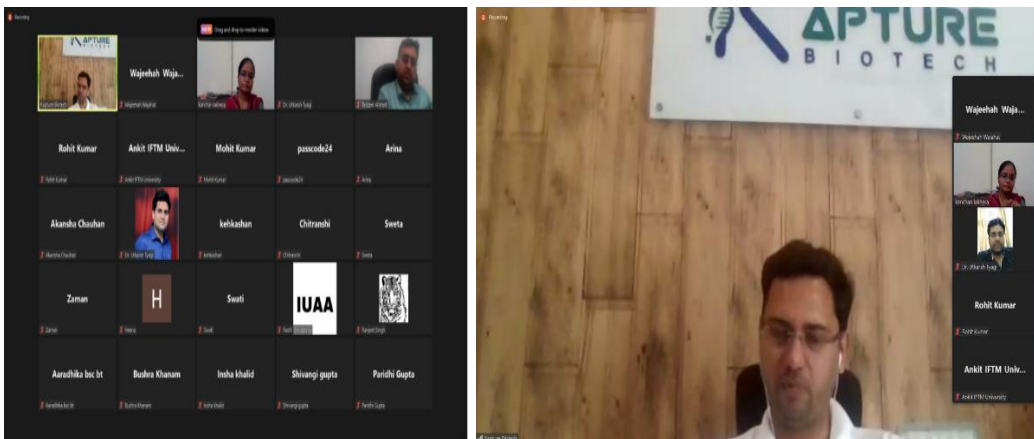

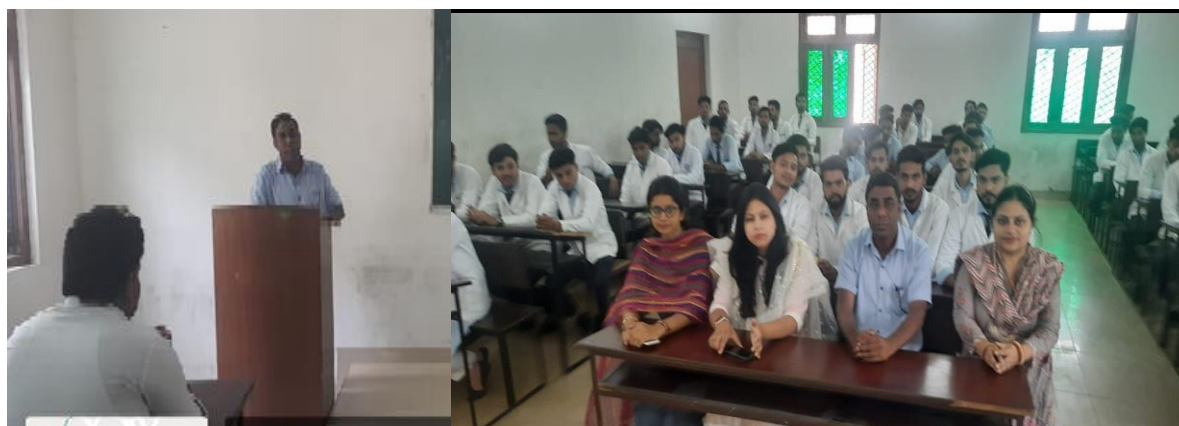

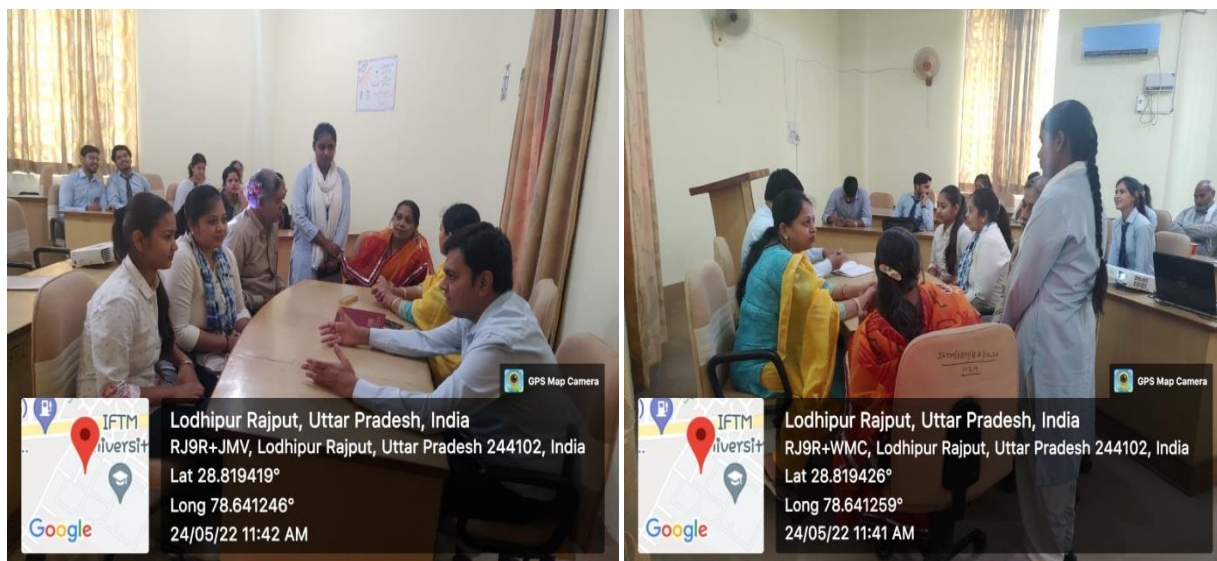

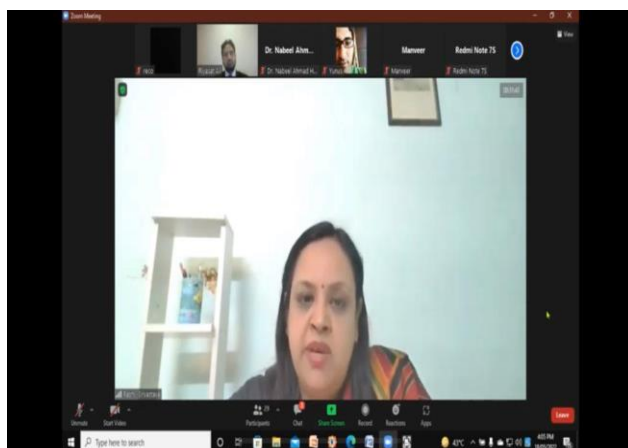

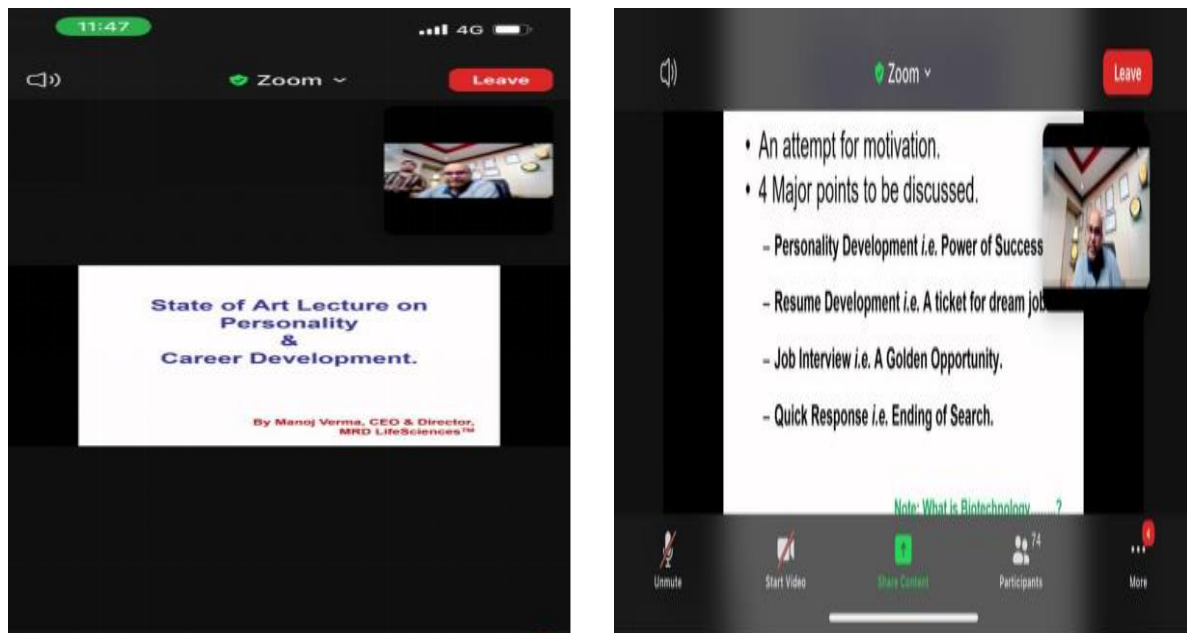

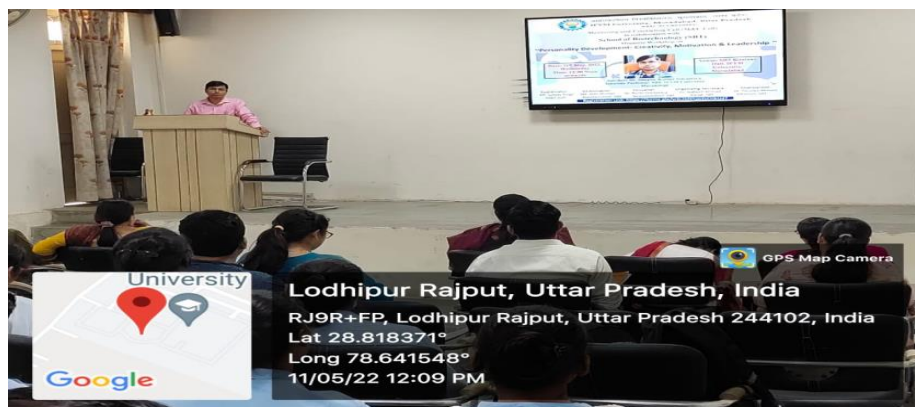

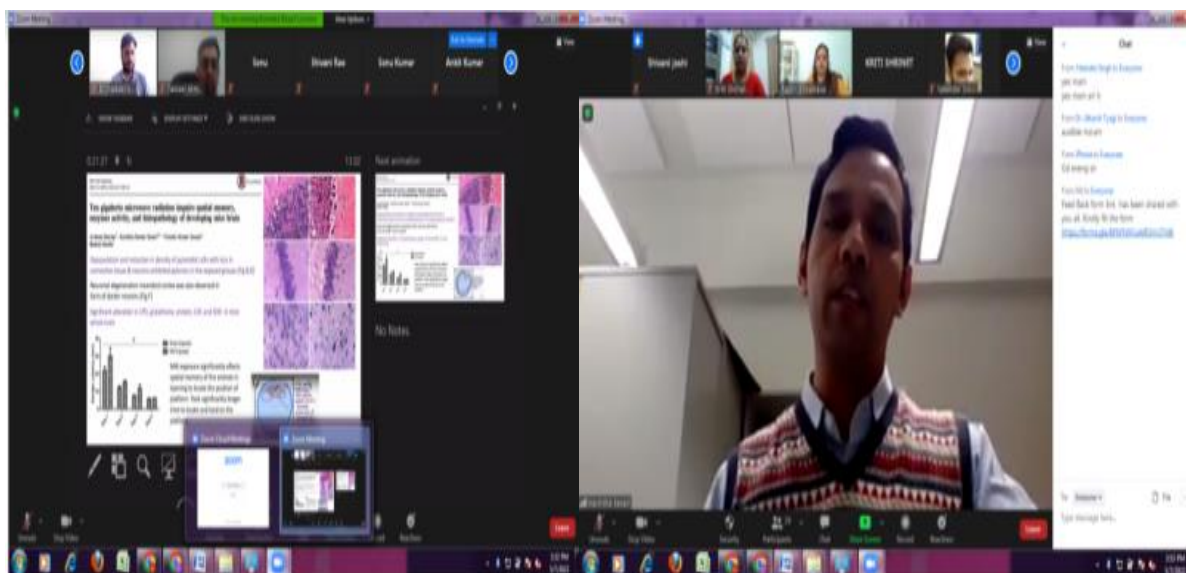

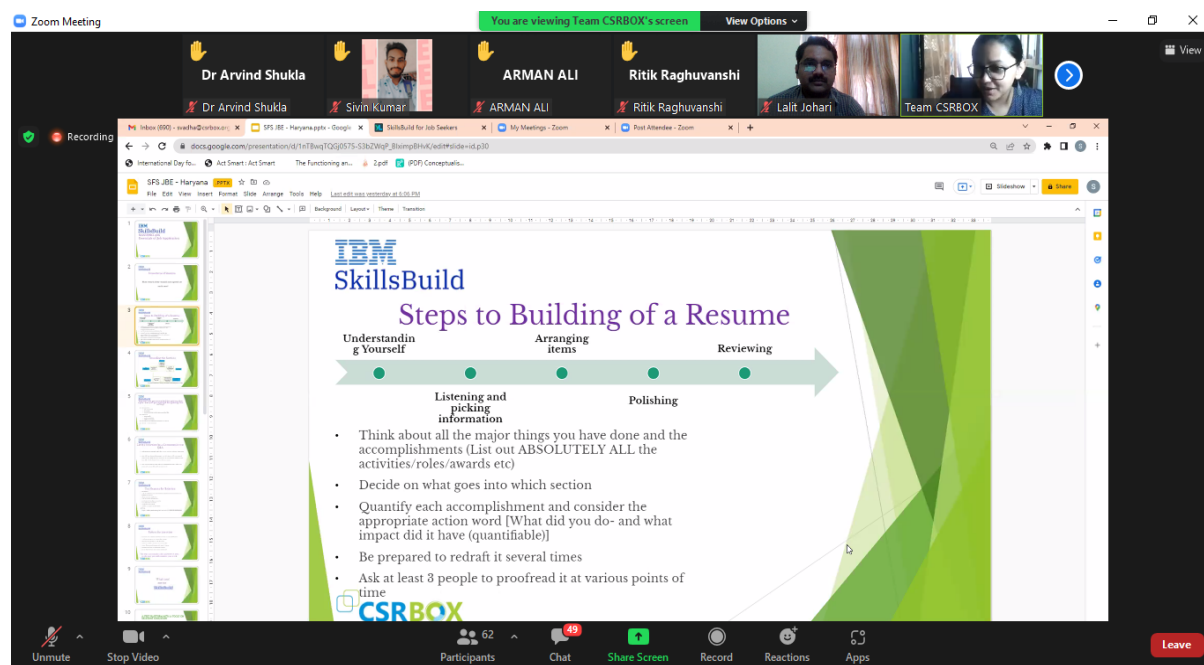

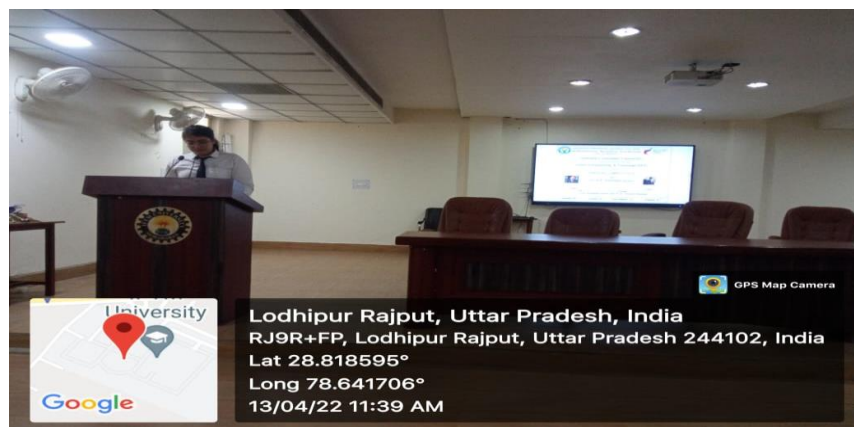

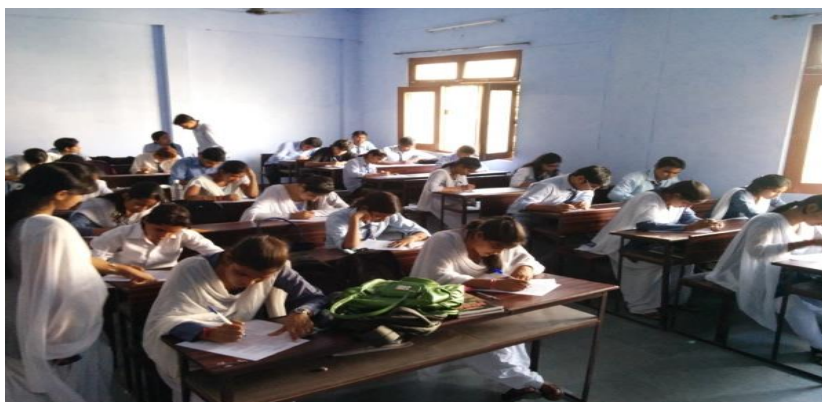

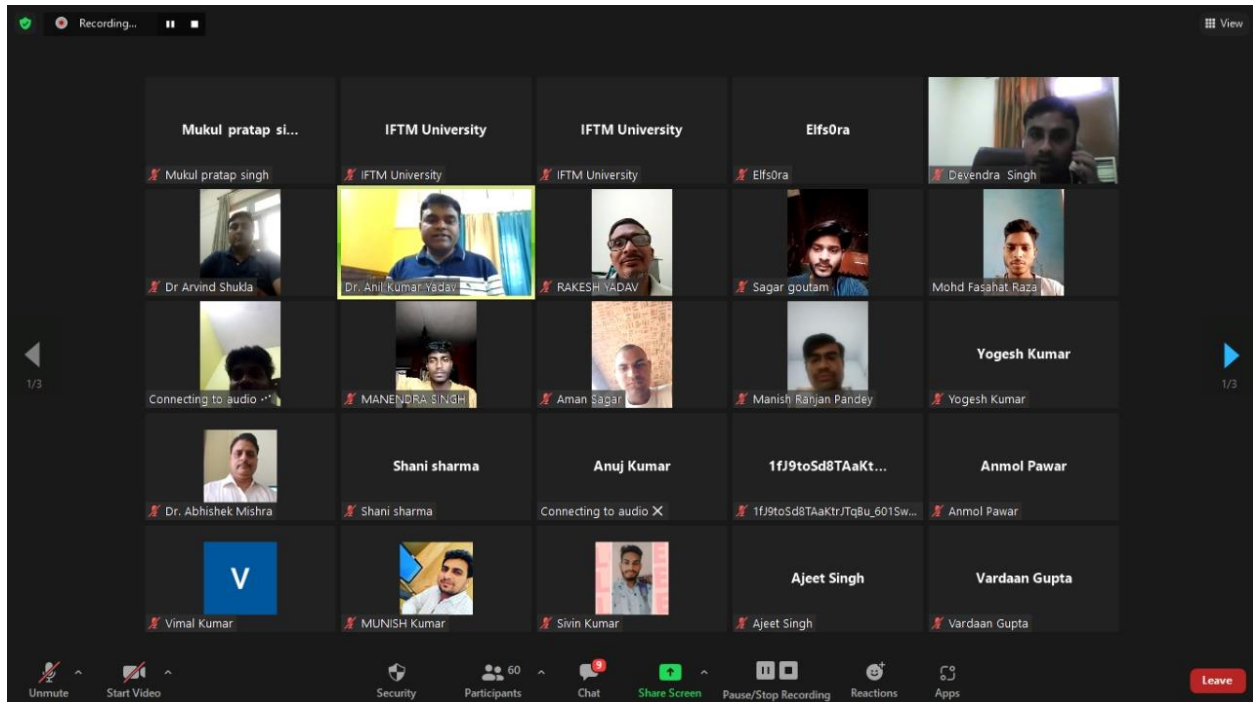

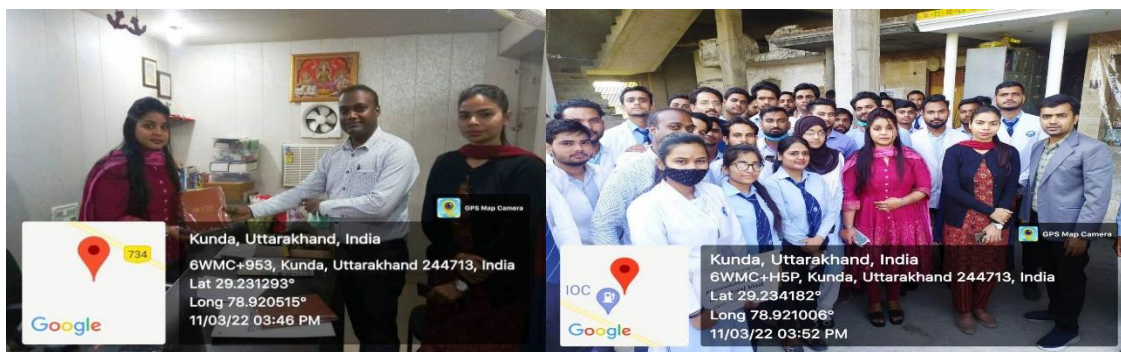

72. Universal Human Values and Ethics

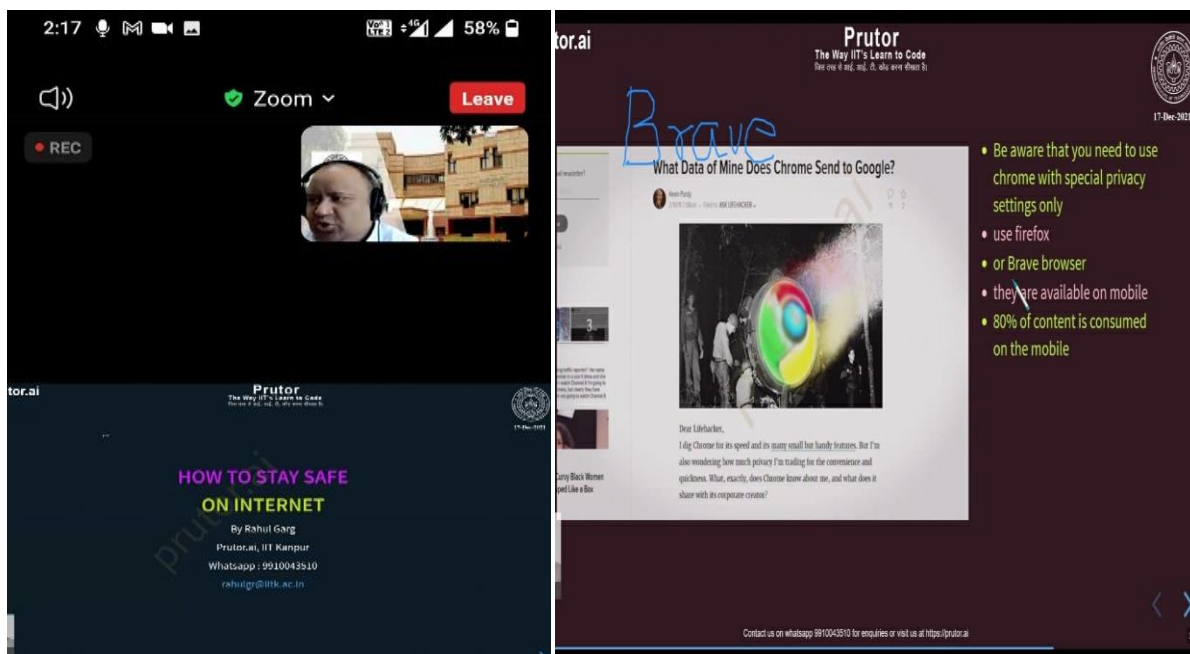

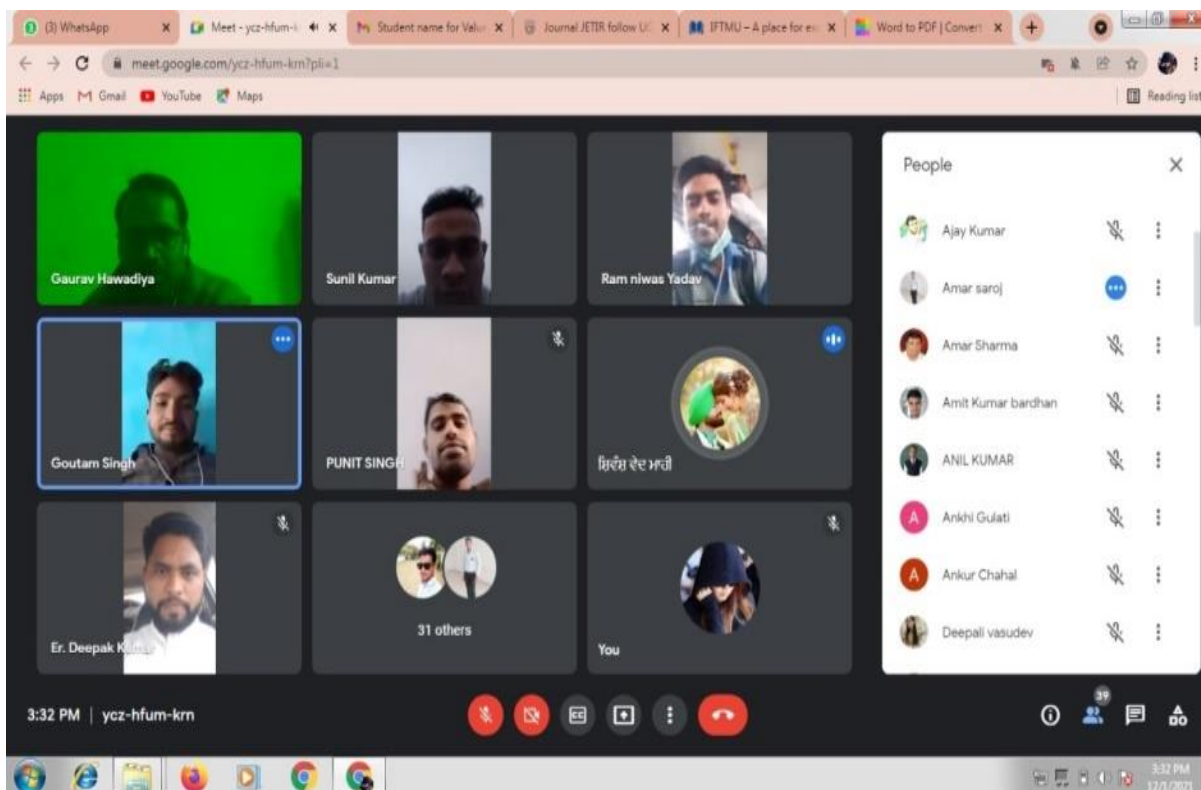

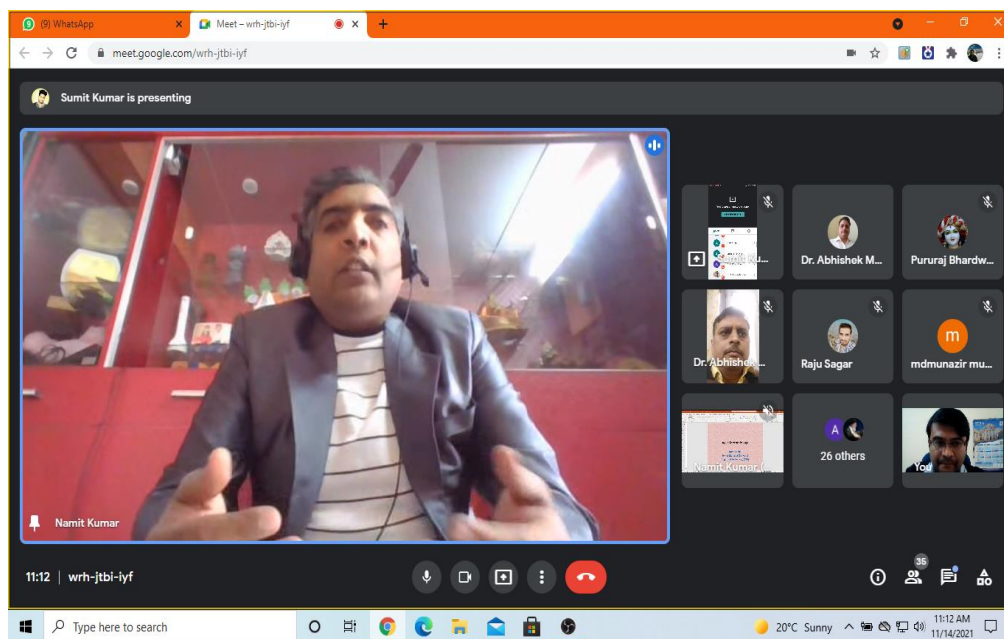

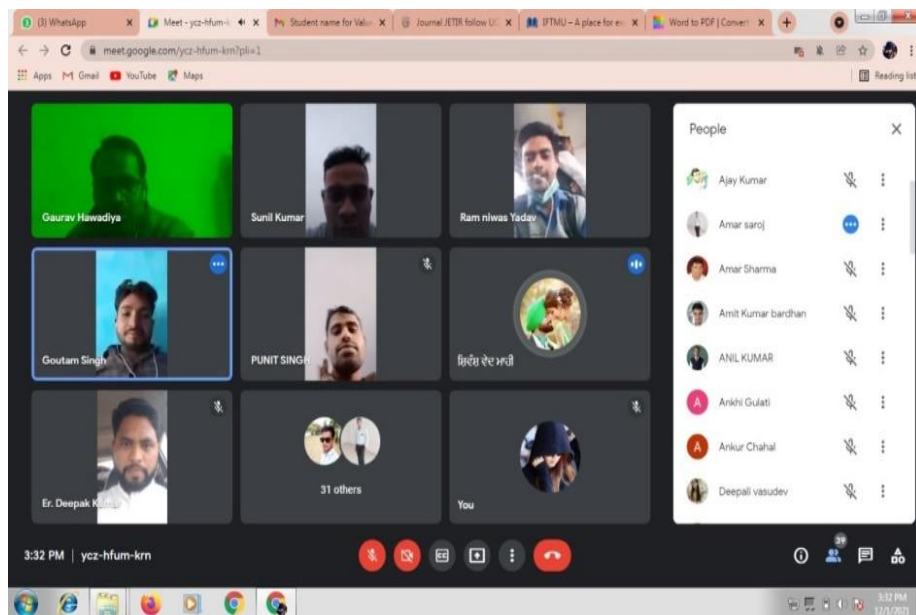

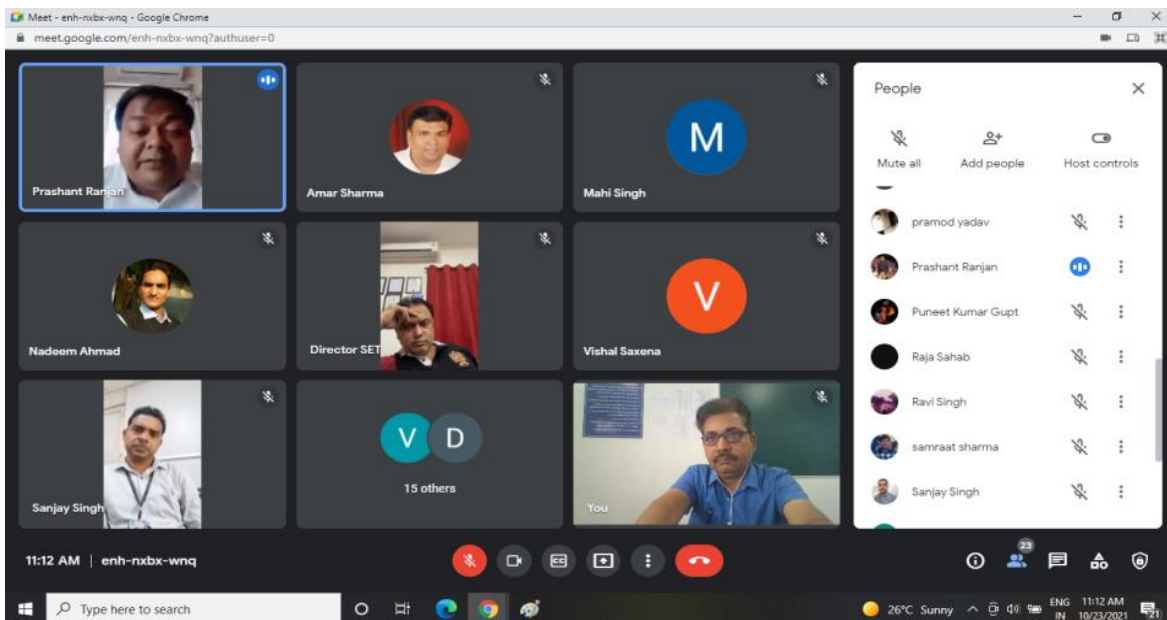

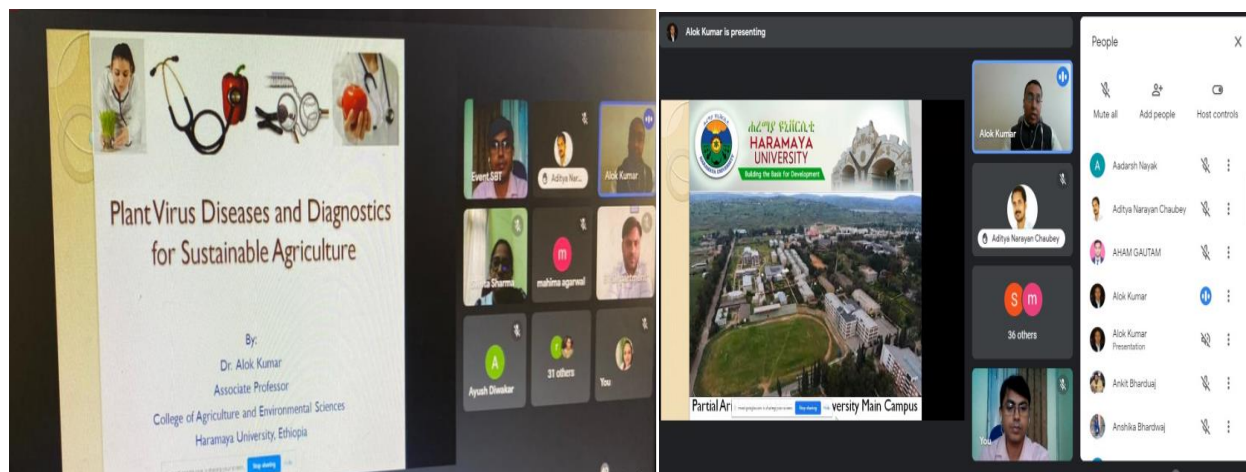

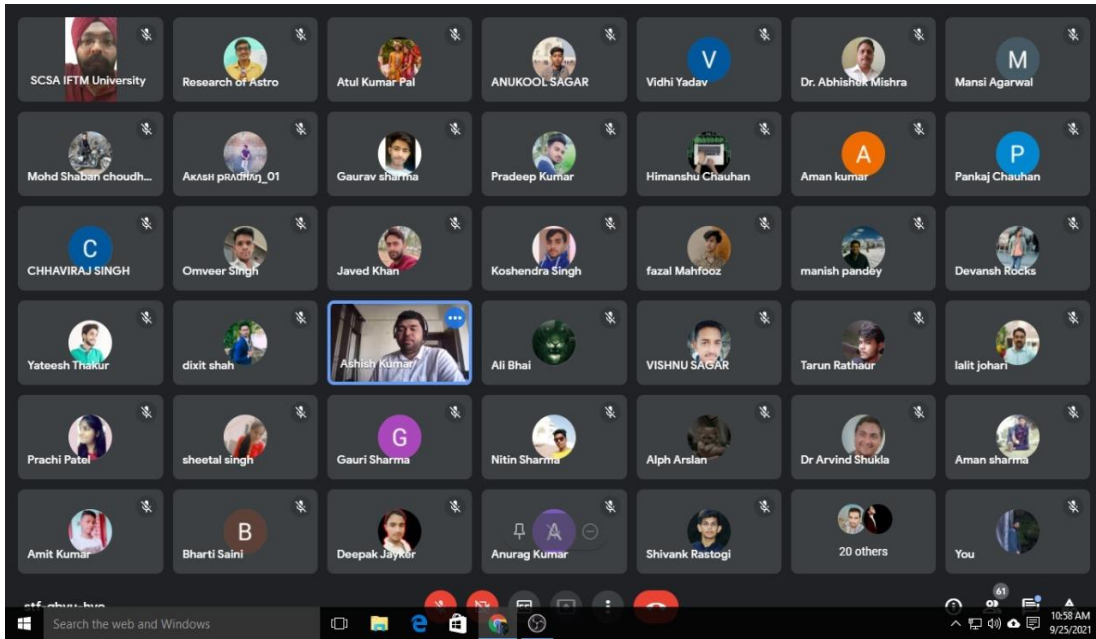

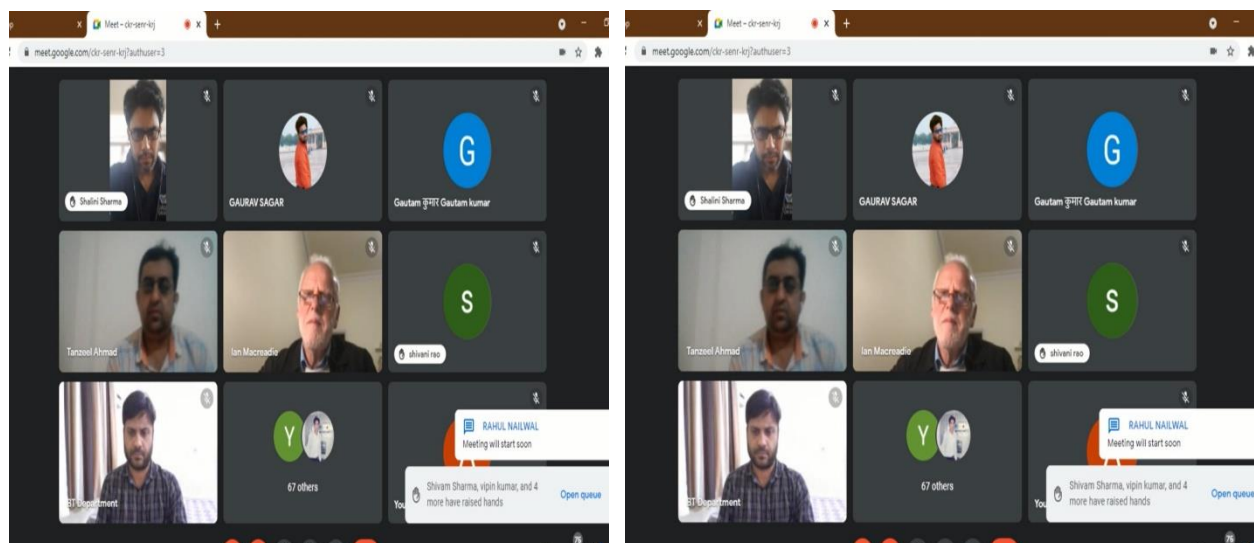

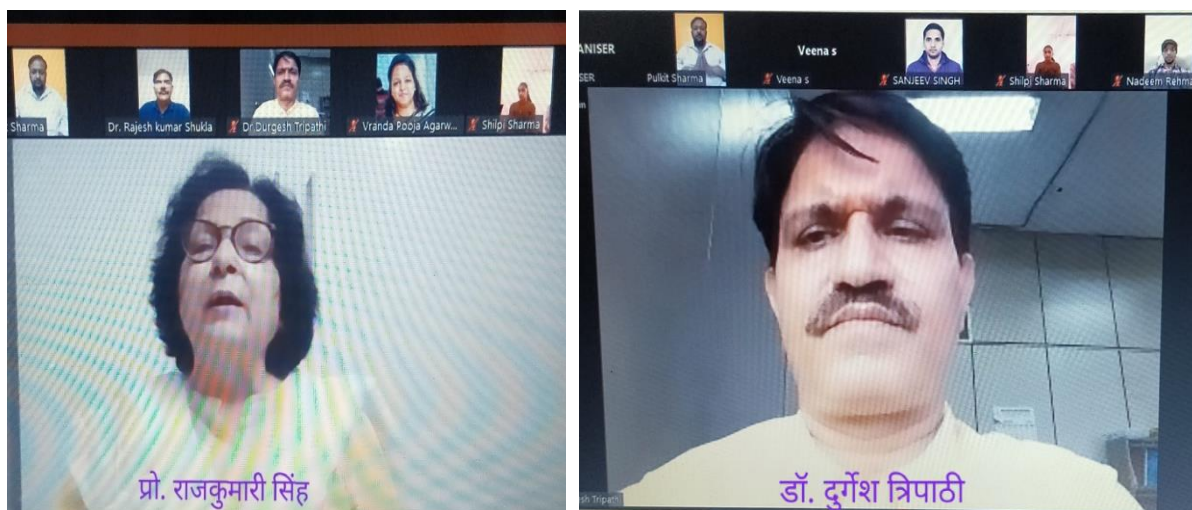

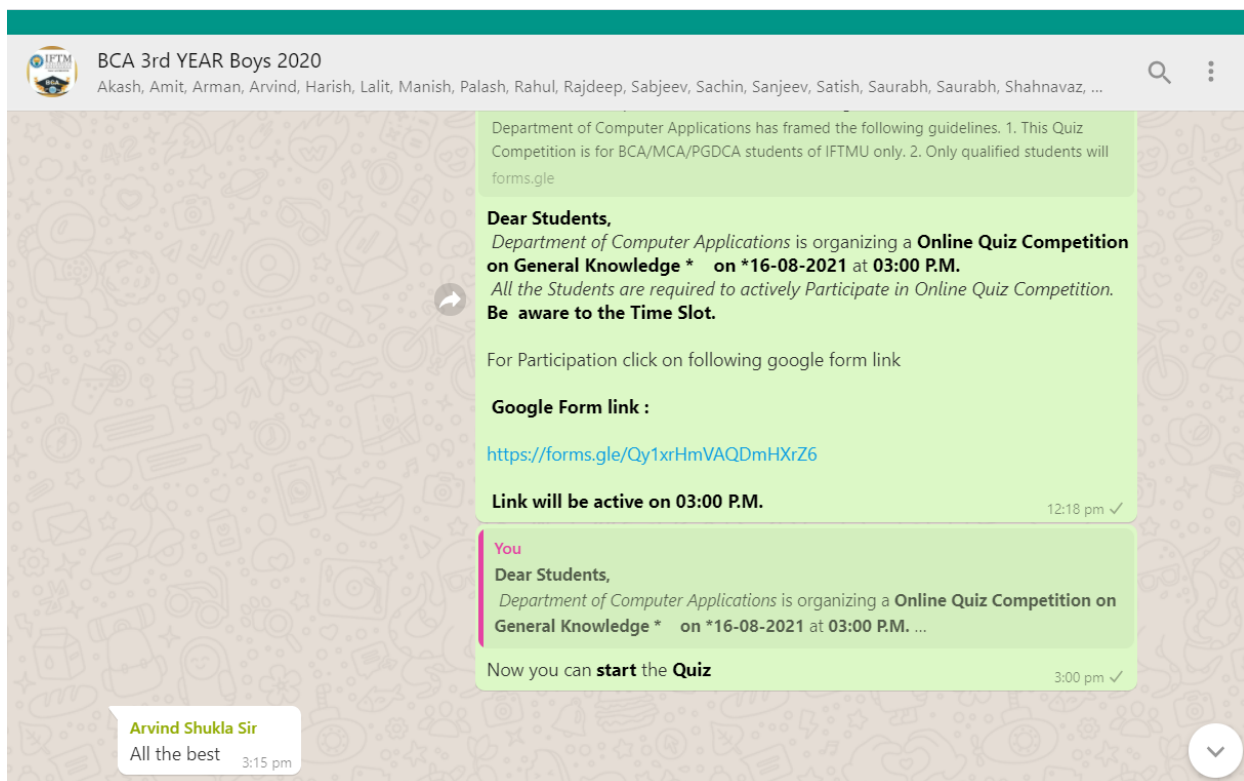

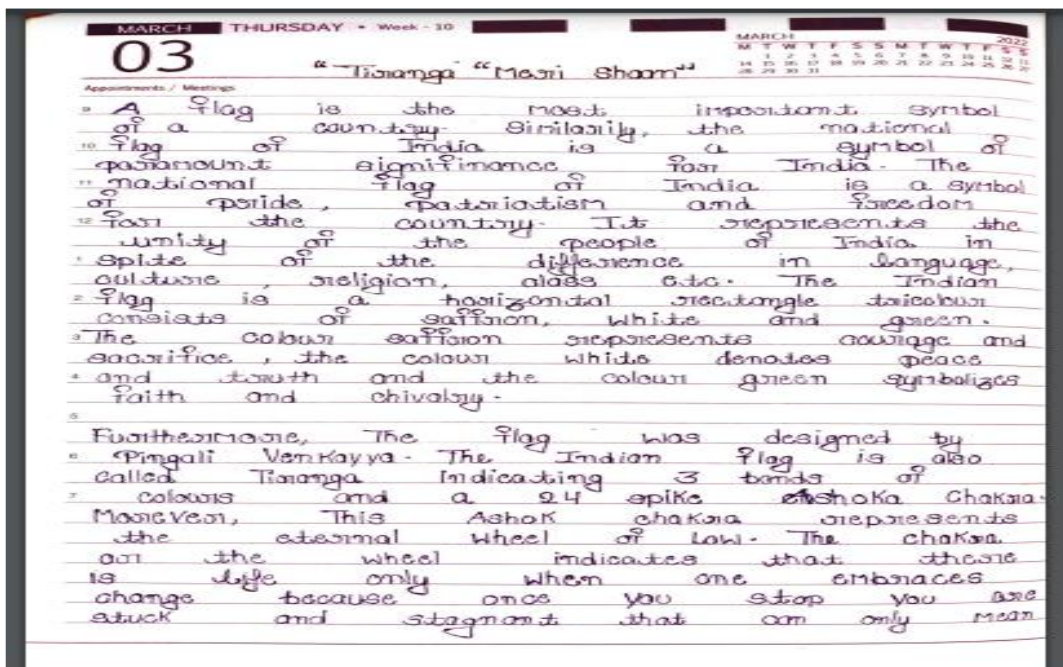

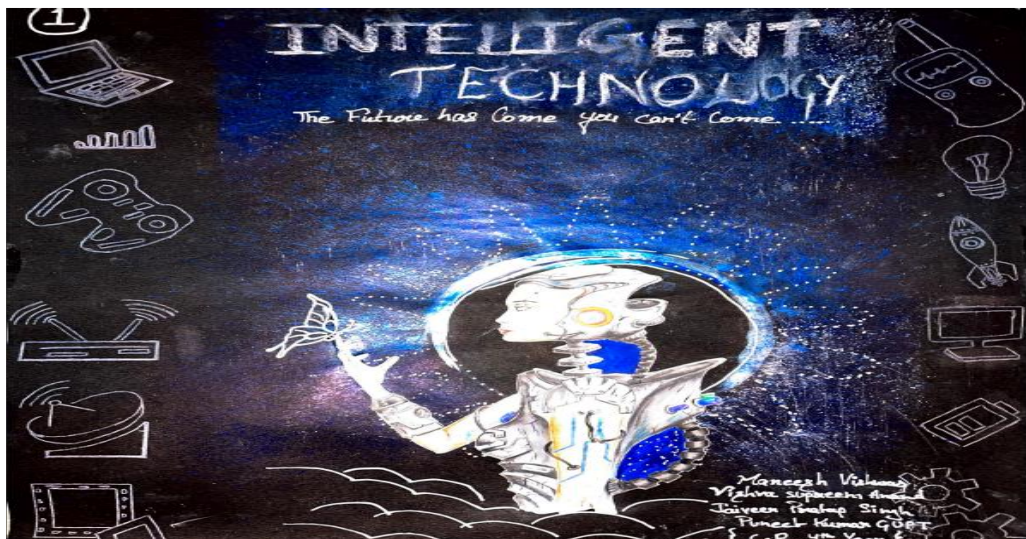


Students displaying their Housekeeping talent

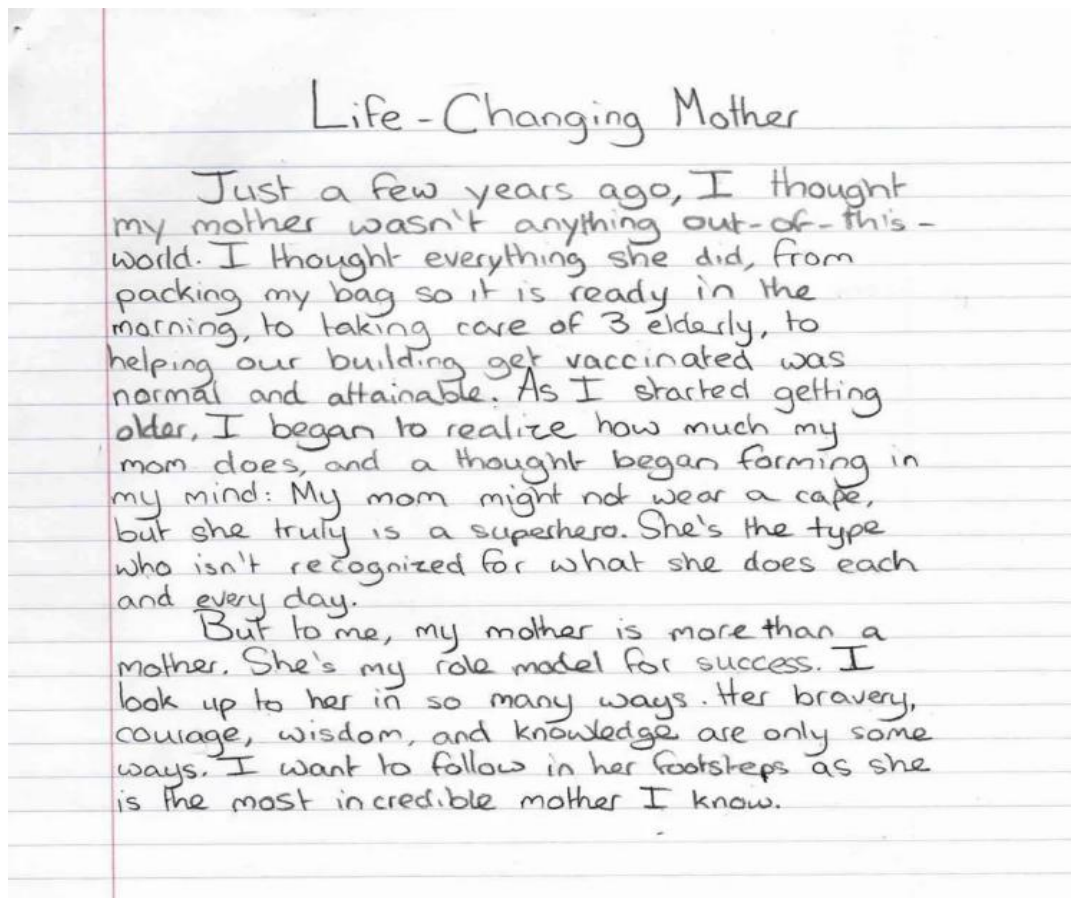


Poster made by a student during the competition

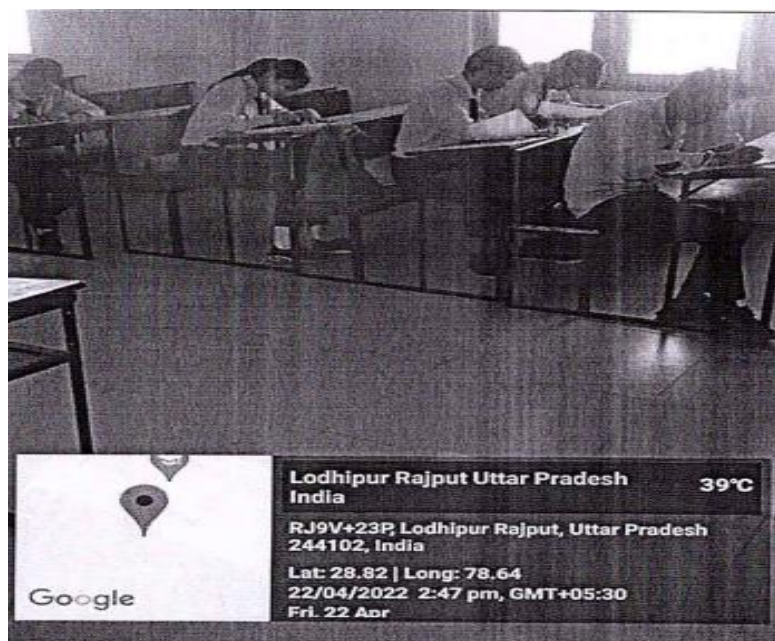

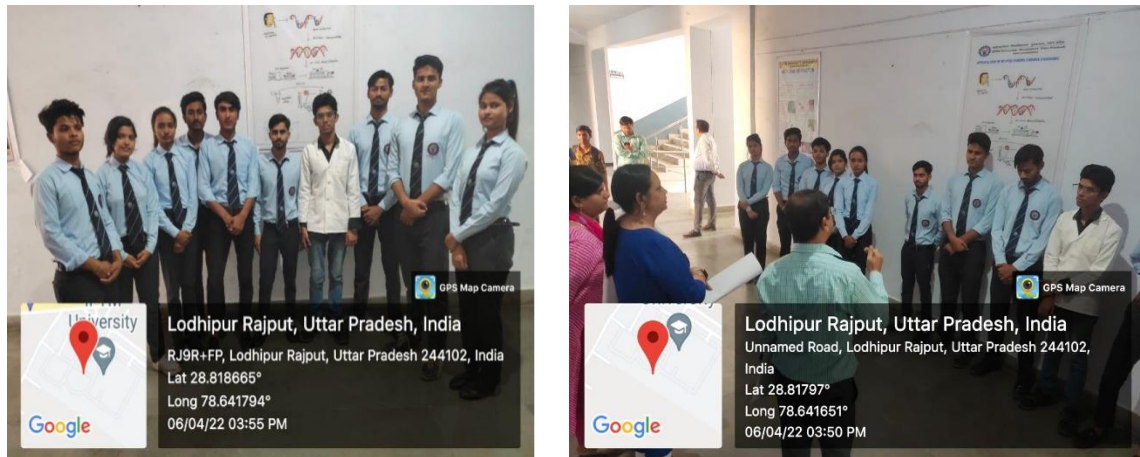

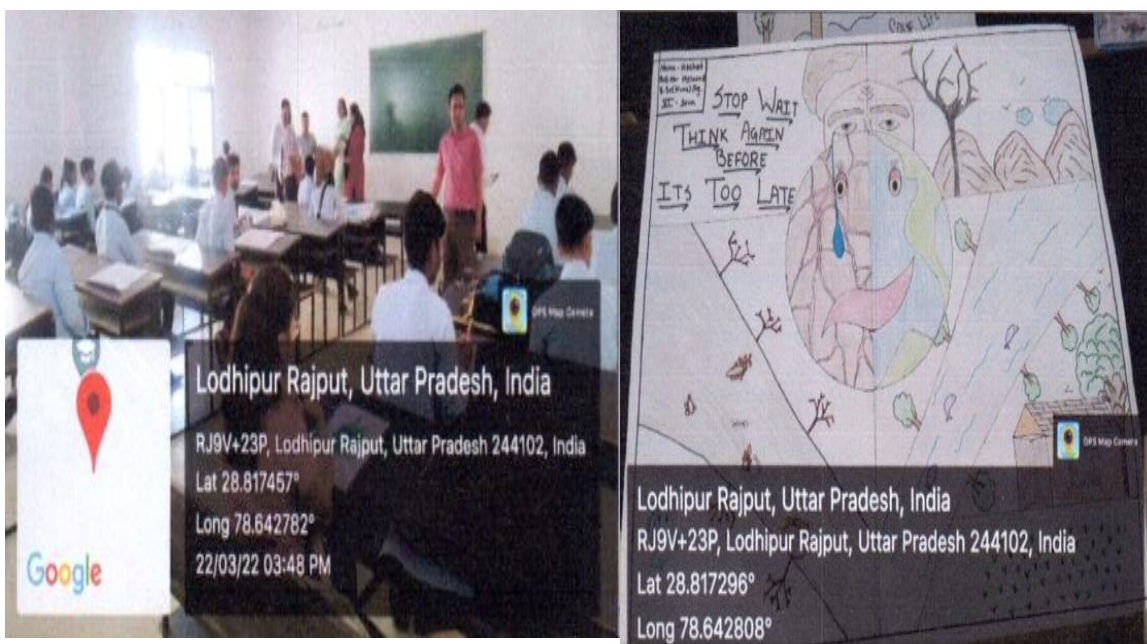

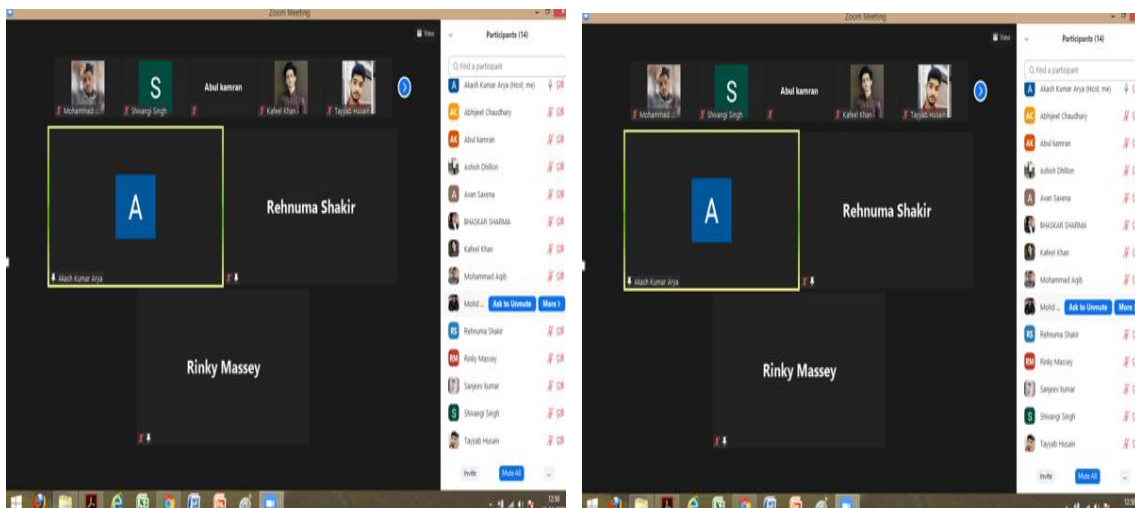


Winners of the photography competition held on the occasion of World Food Day

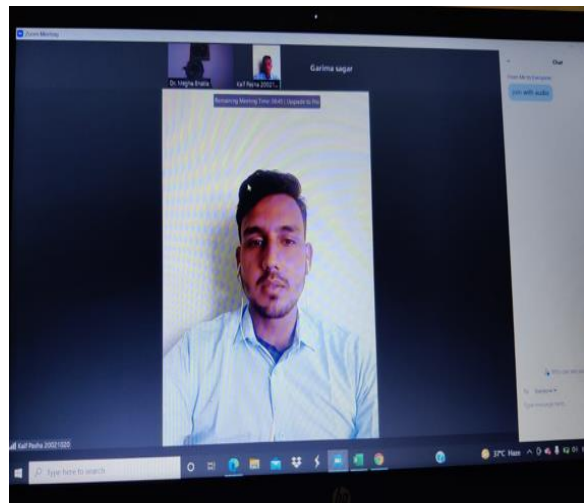
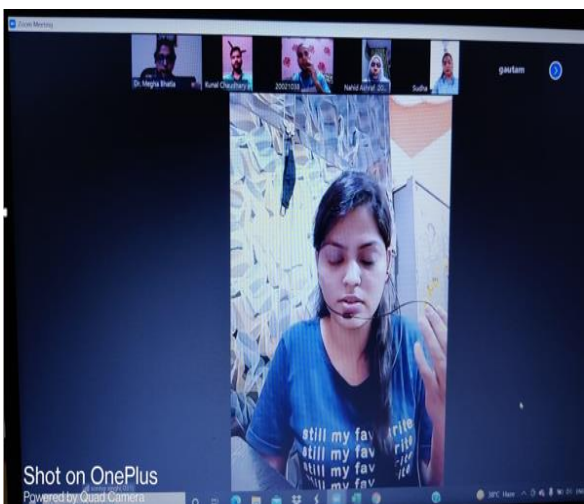
