The abstract, full text paper and power point presentation should be sent through e-mail at seminarsss@iftmuniversity.ac.in till September 20, 2023. The abstract should not exceed 300 words. It should clearly state the objective, methodology and summary of results. It should also include title of the abstract, the author's name and designation, Institutional affiliation, mailing address, contact number and e-mail ID. The abstract should be typed in (Times New Roman/ Krutidev) font size as 12/14 with 1.5 lining space. The length of full paper including tables, diagrams, illustrations, references, etc. should be between 3000 to 5000 words. Bibliographical references should be arranged alphabetically and given at the end of the text in the APA/MLA format. The full version of paper should be submitted in soft copy latest by September 25, 2023 through e-mail at seminarsss@iftmuniversity.ac.in

Publication Plan: Selected full length paper will be published in "Edited Book" with ISBN by reputed publisher. Publication detail will be conveyed to participants through e-mail and Seminar Whtasapp group.
