


ACTION TAKEN REPORT

BASED ON (GENERAL FEEDBACK ANALYSIS) 2019-20

SCHOOL OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCE & ENGINEERING



Based on the feedback survey conducted for the year 2019-20, a down trend was observed in some of the vital parameters. To address the issues, following measures were planned / taken.

S.NO.	ISSUE	ACTION
_1	Not all the former students were willing to contribute to the department as its alumnus.	The alumni coordinators contacted the passed out students of 2018-19 and explored opportunities to have these alumni at the campus in some events, once normalcy restores and restrictions are lifted.
2	Some former students shared their dissatisfaction with the library / reading room	The reading room is provisioned to accommodate students according to their assigned schedule / timetable. Outside it the space becomes scarce and becomes available after the usual class hours.
3	Lesser number of students were found satisfied with the training and placement provided by the University.	Director – T&P through his team explored more hands-on / live projects / field projects to help students acquaint with the real work life challenges. New organizations came on board to provide industry projects and full time job opportunities. a. Prospective employers covering various functions and industries were explored and reviewed for their suitability. b. Number of opportunities offered, types of roles offered, location and CTC offered, employers with high attrition rate (for our students), students' response to the opportunities viz. whether they applied, appeared and what was their performance (rejection, rejection level OR selection, joining and exit), was analyzed and appropriate measures including sessions with final year students, were taken.
